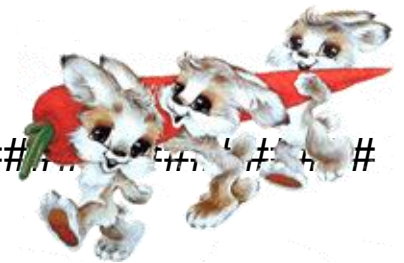

## April Showers Bring.....

Riding season is upon us. We have been riding a lot the last couple weeks. We are more confident of our ability on the bikes. Now comes the liquid snow flakes. Where did the dry roads go? The good thing is, there is no salt or other chemicals from the winter to be washed off the roads. The only thing now is that we have wet roads to deal with.

Number One factor on wet roads is SLOW DOWN!!!! I am amazed how many people drive on wet roads like they do on dry ones. There are markings on the road that are slippery when they get wet. With four wheels and one losing traction is bad enough. With two wheels and one losing traction, half of the stability is gone. Not just less, gone. I know for me that when this would happen, I am not sure about my heart. That will scare you to, as one rider put it, leading the rest of the group in prayer. There may be a lot more things happening. So let's not risk it.

The things that you can control are as follows:

1. Don't stop on the white markings at the light. If you are first, stay back. If you see you are going to be braking on them, keep going. You are close enough not to run a red light. If you run a red light, you weren't paying enough attention at the beginning.
2. When stop at this boogers, stay back from them. That way you can take off and let off the throttle when you are on them. Coasting across them is not threatening as accelerating across them.
3. Stay off the yellow and white lines. This is much more important in wet weather. You don't have to get around Grandpa or Grandma or anyone else that bad. Stay back, relax and enjoy the ride. They will turn off or you will turn off soon enough. If not, stop. Go get a hot cup of coffee or Mountain Dew. Take a break. Anything.
4. Watch for puddles on the road. If the road is wore, stay out of the tracks. That is where the most water will be. Stay back from other vehicles. You will be able to see the road and not have their spray on you at the same time. Pot holes you won't see because they are full of water. So just look for the puddles and you will miss the pot holes.

That should be enough to get you thinking. You will have more I am sure and that is great. You are thinking and now you will be able to ride more safely. Now you can go and do what we all enjoy and that is.....RIDE!!!

# Julie Kochert's Computer Tip for the Month

By request, here's some information for those that send email to lots of people. Bcc is an abbreviation for blind carbon copy. If you add a recipient's name to the **Bcc** box in an e-mail message, a copy of the message is sent to the recipient, but the recipient's name is not visible to the other recipients of the message. If the **Bcc** box is not visible when you create a new message, you can add it. In a new message, on the **Message Options** tab, in the **Fields** group, click **Show Bcc**.

**Pave the way** - Before you add an intended recipient's name to the **Bcc** box in a message, make sure that the recipient is expecting your message. That person may need to take steps to establish you as a safe sender (or a safe recipient, if your name will be in the **To** box of the message). Why is this necessary? Using Bcc is a favorite technique of spammers. Therefore, a lot of junk e-mail filters flag messages that use the **Bcc** box as junk. So if your intended recipient has not added your name to the Safe Senders List (Safe Senders List: A list of domain names and e-mail addresses that you want to receive messages from. E-mail addresses in Contacts and in the Global Address Book are included in this list by default. People you sent messages to will be added to the list.) in Microsoft Office Outlook, your message may go straight to the Junk E-mail folder or its equivalent.

**Keep the recipient list private** - Bcc can help you to be respectful of others' privacy by keeping them in the loop without disclosing their identities. For example, if you send a job announcement to multiple people, you may want to use Bcc to keep the identities of the potential job seekers private.

**Reduce spam** - Although people who send junk e-mail or spam may like to use Bcc, they won't like it if you use it. If you hide the recipients' names by listing them in the **Bcc** box, no one will be able to copy the recipients' e-mail addresses from your messages.

# YOUR Chapter Couple of the Year - Ron & Bev

Every year about this time I start seeing a rabbit in our neighborhood, and I always tell the grandchildren that I have already seen the Easter Bunny and he was scoping out the area.

I became curious about the origin of the Easter Bunny, so I did some internet research.

The origin of the Easter Bunny has roots that go back to pre-Christian, Anglo-Saxon history. The holiday was originally a pagan celebration that worshipped the goddess Eastre. She was the goddess of fertility and springtime and her earthly symbol was the rabbit – not surprising since the rabbit is one of the most common symbols of fertility. (I guess hers was the “Eastre Bunny”.) The timing of the Christian celebration of Easter (to Christians this word represents the time frame and the events revolving around Jesus Christ’s death and resurrection) is around the time of the vernal equinox, which is linked historically with the pagan celebration that coincides with the arrival of spring.

The colored eggs carried by today's Easter bunnies have another, even more ancient origin. Eggs have long been associated with fertility and springtime festivals - for so long, in fact, that the precise roots of the association are unknown. Many Christians dye their Easter eggs red-the color of blood in recognition of the blood of Christ; and some use green as a symbol of everlasting life.

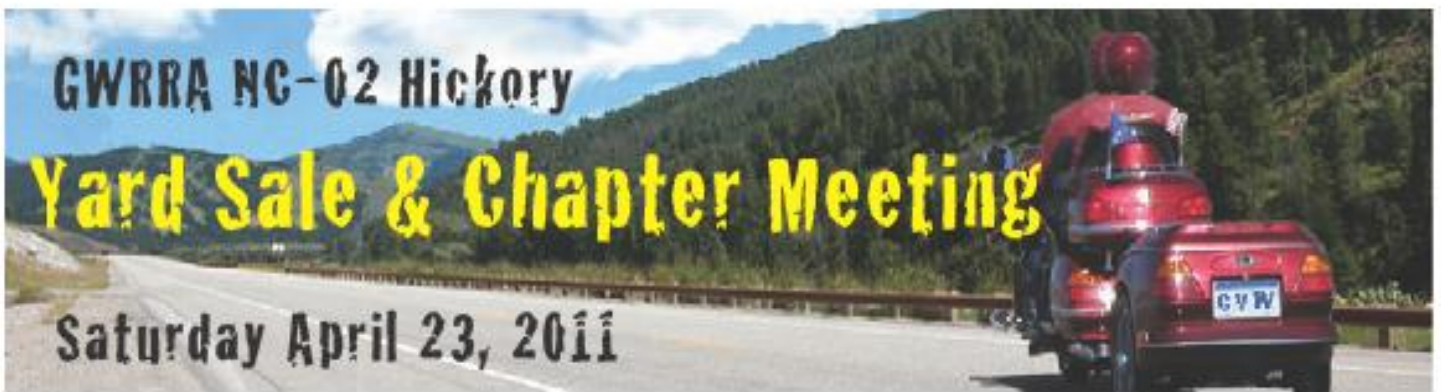
The Easter Bunny was introduced to the US by the German settlers in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. Children would build brightly colored nests, often out of caps and bonnets, in secluded areas of their homes. The Easter Bunny would, if the children had been good, lay brightly colored Eggs in the nest. At that time eggs were boiled with spring flowers to give them color. As the tradition spread, the nest has become the manufactured, modern Easter basket, and the placing of the nest in a secluded area has become the tradition of hiding baskets.

I guess sometimes it does not always pay to do a lot of research. I must say I was disappointed to learn that the word “Easter” came from the pagan worship of Eastre and her celebration of fertility (“Bunny”).

So maybe I will just say it’s Resurrection Sunday, instead of Easter Sunday.

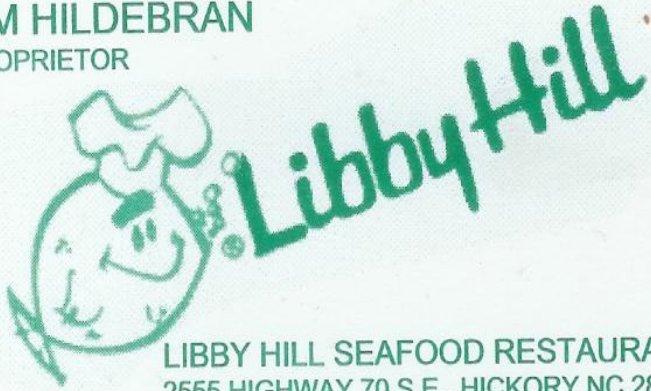
